SEMOpx Decision in relation to SEMOpx SPX_01_19 (SEMOpx Data Publication Guide v2)

Dear Exchange Members,

On 7th May 2019, ESB submitted its Modification Proposal Form with regard to the SEMOpx Operating Procedures in accordance with Paragraph J.2.1.1 of the SEMOpx Rules.

The Modification Proposal was discussed at the exchange committee meeting on 29th May 2019. The aim of the modification was to ensure that any change to market data submission requirements must be discussed at a designated market forum and that these data submission requirements should not be alterable outside of this change control process. The proposer justified the modification on the basis of SEMOpx Objectives (b), (d), (e) and (f) i.e. that this approach would promote competitive outcomes through provision of efficient and effective exchange services; be transparent, not unduly discriminate, and promote market integrity and confidence; reflect the system design and capabilities and service provider arrangements; and provide exchange members with opportunities to be consulted on charges to SEMOpx Rules and Procedures.

SEMOpx consulted with the Exchange Committee on this Modification Proposal, considering their views and the SEMOpx Objectives in deciding whether or not to modify the SEMOpx Procedures. An amendment to the timelines for data submission (to take account of existing timelines and feasibility in terms of systems), was proposed by SEMOpx and was supported by Exchange Members. The Modification Proposal V2 (including the amendment proposed by SEMOpx) was supported unanimously by the exchange committee members.

Considering Modification Proposal SEMOpx SPX_01_19 and in accordance with Paragraph J.4.2.1 of the SEMOpx Rules, SEMOpx approves Modification Proposal SEMOpx SPX_01_19 (SEMOpx Data Publication Guide v2) (inclusive of the amendment proposed by SEMOpx) and which will be effective 5 Working Days from the date hereof.
