# **Explanation of Proposed Change**

(mandatory by originator)

This modification proposes to update the SEMOpx Operating Procedures to reflect the implementation of a new report for the publication of the SDAC 60Min Harmonised Reference Price. No changes are required to the SEMOpx Rules.

SDAC NEMOs agreed<sup>1</sup> to use a joint calculation method of a SDAC 60' average price as of the go-live of the SDAC 15MTU project (SEM DAM30'MTU). All NEMOs agreed to publish locally, a harmonized SDAC 60' average price based on the data calculated by SDAC algorithm (EUPHEMIA). This DAM 60Min Reference Price in the SEM will be an arithmetic average of the DAM 30Min prices and will only be used as an index/reference and not for clearing or settlement purposes.

This change is only applicable to the Day-Ahead Market. No changes are required to the Intraday Auctions or Intrady Continuous Market. Target go-live date: 11<sup>th</sup> June 2025 (for Delivery Date: 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025).

#### **Modification Proposal Justification**

This modification seeks to amend the SEMOpx Operating Procedures to include the publication of a new report for the SDAC 60Min Harmonised Reference Price to align with all NEMOs in providing 60-minute indices for each EU bidding zone. The requirement to create harmonisation between NEMOs regarding the index publication (including decimal rounding) comes from the Single Day-Ahead Coupling (SDAC) level and was agreed by all NEMO Day-Ahead Steering Committee (NEMO DA SC) members in October 2024<sup>2</sup>. SEMOpx, as a member of SDAC, has an obligation to comply with the requirements set by the NEMO DA SC.

- A.1.2.1 These SEMOpx Rules are designed to facilitate achievement of the following objective (the **"SEMOpx Objective"**):
  - (a) That participation and trading in commercially viable and sustainable product offerings in the SEMOpx day-ahead and intraday markets meets the needs of current and prospective Exchange Members, and promotes the long-term interests of consumers.
- A.1.2.2 The SEMOpx Objective is supported by the following principles: that the SEMOpx Rules should:
  - (a) enable compliance with the regulatory requirements of the European Union, Ireland and Northern Ireland;
  - (b) promote competitive outcomes through provision of efficient and effective exchange services;
  - (C) conform with regional and European-wide arrangements for Market Coupling;
  - (d) be transparent, not unduly discriminatory, and promote market integrity and confidence;
  - (e) reflect the system design and capabilities and service provider arrangements;
  - (f) provide Exchange Members with opportunities to be consulted on changes to SEMOpx Rules and Procedures; and
  - (g) promote data security, integrity and confidentiality, being the "SEMOpx Principles".

This modification proposal furthers the SEMOpx Principles (c), and (e), above by ensuring:

- The SEMOpx Operating Procedures align with the implementation of a new report and the updates made to the SEMOpx Data Publication Guide.
- The SEMOpx Operating Procedures accurately reflect the details of the publication of the new report.

#### Implication of not implementing the Modification Proposal
